**COVID 19** –As yet we have had no positive cases among pupils or staff member of our entire school. However we realise that the situation can change and are ready if that does happen. There are strict protocols in place that the school must follow including contacting parents of affected children.

Parents in the playground– Massive thanks for all for wearing masks. Thank you also for not entering the school before 8.50am. We want to make drop-off and pick up as safe as possible.

In the morning, if you do need to come into school can I ask that only P1 parents enter the playground and leave as soon as you have dropped you child off, if there is a member of staff in the playground. Please do not wait for the bell as we would like to increase your safety by preventing high numbers of parents all leaving the playground at the same time.

At 3pm– Thank you for respecting safety and not entering the school before 2.55pm.Can I ask that if you do not need to come into the school at 3pm, that you make a safe place to meet your child.
